EQUANIMITY & EVEN-SIGHTEDNESS IS THE CONSTITUTION OF SATYUG

The change is inevitable, Come and be a part of the change.....

It is universally acknowledged that nature has divided the eternal time into four eras or yugas — Satyug, Tretayug, Dwaparyug and Kalyug, which is the present era.

As per the laws of nature, Satyug - the Golden Era, is definite to follow Kalyug. Therefore, it becomes necessary for all of us to enlighten ourselves about the Golden Era and become competent to mould ourselves accordingly.

The basic difference between the beings of Satyug and Kalyug is that the foundation of the character of beings of Satyug is based on absolute spiritualism, Truth and knowledge of the Self, which helps them retain purity of thoughts at all times. The basis of this is firmness in the practice of Equanimity and Even-Sightedness.

However, with deterioration in the level of commitment to humane values, the basis of character of every being in Kalyug becomes purely materialistic with me and mine as the basis of living which is the root cause of every evil in the world. This mires the mind in lust, anger, greed, pride, attachment etc. Ego, selfishness and negative thinking become the foundation and objective of survival.

This weakens our divine insight and one never becomes aware of Jiva and Brahm and makes the mind dependant on one source or the other to believe that God is somewhere else which leads to invention of various kinds of devotional methods. And the being still leads a life full of depression, weeping and lamenting. It becomes difficult for human beings to retain purity of senses and become one with the Almighty All this happens by breaking the ethical law and principle of Equanimity. We forget that we are not killing, abusing, defaming, cheating or harming anybody else, but ourselves.

While the suffering reaches its peak, mother nature is bound to cleanse the world to bring about next important phase i.e. Satyug, the balm factor. Coming close to God requires one to understand the basics of human virtues correctly, the most important being practicing Equanimity and Even-Sightedness as a part of daily life which is not only the simplest but the most effective Sadhna in one's quest to achieve the prime goal of life but also the only means to bring true peace on earth.

Satvastu Ka Kudarti Granth — The Harbinger of Satyug and True Peace on Earth through Equanimity (Sambhav) and Even-Sightedness (Samdrishti)

Equanimity is the power of mind to stay in a balanced state under all circumstances. Even-Sightedness denotes the state of seeing every one evenly or equally. Compared to all devotions in vogue today, practicing of this discipline is the most powerful and convenient means to achieve the prime goal of life — Self Realization. These represent the basic nature of the Lord and are symbols of excellence and means to prosperity, equality and peace.

By gaining knowledge of Equanimity and Even-Sightedness, a person attains the wisdom of listening to the Eternal Self and power of commitment to imbibe and spread the virtues of his real Self, imparting to himself the perception of experience and the equality of all in the Universe. Such a person acquires complete knowledge pertaining to the Self. Here the mind achieves a stage of omniscience — a state of divinity at which one acquires divine insight of the past, the present and future and wisdom to find that one's Real/Eternal Self manifests everywhere and visualizes one's own glimpse everywhere, and in everyone.

A continuous practice helps to achieve a stage of realization that there is no birth or death, no joy or sorrow, no sickness or grief and no poverty or riches. This wisdom makes one limitless, wealthiest of all and most noble person. Here one attains a state of limitless bliss, a realization of being Omnipotent, Omnipresent, and Omniscient.

This has been quoted in the holy book Satvastu Ka Kudarti Granth, which means Sacred Scripture of Satyug as revealed by the Nature, which narrates that in 'Satyug' each one would be the lover of truth having high integrity and uniform vision and would love to live in harmony and peace. This holy book is the guiding force for all of us.

According to this holy book, Equanimity and Even-Sightedness can be described as:

"Holding oneself firmly in contentment, truthfulness, endurance and righteousness, while keeping one's thought, speech and action in an independent state. i.e., free from any negativity and with a firm belief in the omnipresence of God —evenly visualizing His Eternal light in all living and non-living world beings."


Prayer of Sajan Shri Shehanshah Mahabir Ji

1. To keep one's thought, speech and action in a pure and independent state, i.e. free from any negativity or tempting pulsations. To do so, it is essential to root our existence in the divine source of the Universe, i.e. 'God', and to firmly remain committed to His command.
2. To firmly resolve to practice Equanimity and Even-Sightedness from the very childhood and ensure that one's thought, speech and action function according

to the established rule of conduct. The basic principle of which is: "Even Vision-One Philosophy".

3. Always keep in mind that "Discern nonetheless but me (Real/ Eternal Self) is the 'Lord'""Only ignorant say that the Lord is someone along with" .
4. "The Word of God is our Master, not the figure, idol or image of any person". So, we should not meditate on or worship any figure, idol or image of any person.
5. Firmly hold the values of contentment, endurance, truthfulness, selflessness & righteousness and all

other virtues.

6. Accept the truth that God is Omnipotent, Omnipresent and Omniscient.
7. Accept that we all are equal. Ensure that mind rises above caste, creed, religion, riches, poverty, weakness etc. (Root causes of discrimination /dualism).
8. Mould attitude, behaviour, habits and lifestyle to adopt the virtues of the Lord and to always remain in a balanced and even state of mind at all times in any condition of life.


